Defendants involved in Albuquerque beating filed A Motion.

St. Michaels, Navajo Nation- The Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission will be traveling to Albuquerque, NM for a hearing concerning defendants Alex Rios, 18, Nathaniel Carrillo, 16, and Gilbert Tafoya, 15, the three teens who are accused of beating to death Allison Gorman and Kee Thompson.

A motion hearing will be held tomorrow at 2:00 P.M. at the Second Judicial District Court at 400 Lomas Blvd. NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico. The Honorable Judge Briana H. Zamora will be presiding.

In July 19, 2014, the three Albuquerque teen defendants admitted in having a role in the beating of two Navajo men with metal pipes, sticks and cinder blocks.
