## RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO NATION HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION

# Approving the Regular Meeting Dates for the Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission for the Four-Year Term Covering 2024 to 2028

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §920 and §921, the Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission (herein referred to as "Commission") is established within the Legislative Branch as an entity of the Navajo Nation government and is organized to operate as a clearinghouse entity to administratively address discriminatory actions against citizens of the Navajo Nation, and to interface with the local, state, federal governments and with national and international human rights organizations in accordance with the Commission's plan of operation (Navajo Nation Council Resolution CJN-15-08) and applicable laws and regulations of the Navajo Nation; and
- 2. Pursuant to the Plan of Operation, Section IV (B) Meetings and Procedures, the Commission must establish a regular meeting schedule which will provide for at least one meeting day per month; and
- 3. By Resolutions NABIS-52-24, NABIS-53-24 and NABIS-54-24, three commissioners are confirmed by the Naabik'íyát'i' Committee of the 25th Navajo Nation Council. The Social Services and Business positions have not been appointed by the Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council and confirmed by the Naabik'íyát'i' Committee of the 25th Navajo Nation Council.

### NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission hereby approves and establishes its regular meetings to be held on the second Thursday of each month for the 2024-2028 Commission, except the Commission shall conduct a regular meeting on November 8, 2024.
- 2. The Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission further hereby directs and authorizes that Resolution NNHRCNOV-15-20 is superseded by this resolution, and therefore rescinded.
